



SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Wax Paper Sheet
- Ball of Clay
- PVC Pipe Rolling Pin
- Skewer
- Shells
- Baby Wipes

WHAT TO DO:

Each kid will:

1. Lay out the sheet of wax paper on their desk
2. Flatten out their ball of clay
3. Roll the clay with the PVC rolling pin to about 1/4' thick and big enough for their hand
4. Press their hand into the clay for a hand imprint. They may have to stand and use their other hand to push their fingers into the clay
5. Use the skewer to write their name and year
6. Decorate by pressing shells into the clay
7. Clay will take about 48 hours to dry, so set aside in the classroom until Wednesday before putting into their VBS Bag



BOTTOM LINE RESPONSE:

Describe your favorite places in God's creation: beach, forest, mountains, lakes, rivers, deserts, etc. Ask the kids to share their favorite part of God's creation. Then say, "One of God's favorite parts of creation is YOU! He created you with a purpose. Let's say today's Bottom Line together: God made people with a purpose."
